SERVICES

- Driver License **Renewal**, fee \$48.
NOTE: Additional \$15 is due for late renewal of expired license.
- Driver License **Replacement**, \$25.
- ID Card **Original, Renewal or Replacement**, \$25.
- CDL License - **Renewal**, \$75.
- **STOLEN** Driver License or ID card, \$25; or Free with a Police Report stating it's stolen, not just lost.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS:

1. **Identification: Bring one**
 - Certified U.S. birth certificate
 - Valid U.S. passport
 - Certificate of naturalization
 - Consular proof of birth abroad
 - Alien registration receipt card (green card, form 1-551)
- Name Change** (if applicable)
 - Original or certified copy of marriage certificates/court orders showing your name change (uncertified copies are not valid)
2. **SS Number: Bring one**
 - Social Security card
 - W-2 form
 - Pay check showing SS#
 - Any 1099 form
3. **Residential Address** (not PO box): **Bring two**
 - Deed, mortgage or lease
 - Florida vehicle registration/title
 - Utility bill
 - Statement from person you live with along with 2 address documents in that person's name.
