The lane closure does not grant the right to close the lanes at all times, nor for a period longer than 30 days, but intermittently or as necessary. Furthermore I understand that any permit(s) that may be granted based on this application is subject to enforcement under the City Code of Ordinances, under any attached requirements, and must be surrendered upon demand to the City Code Compliance Department, Sunny Isles Beach Police Department and/or their representatives.
