

TWENTY-FIFTH EXTENSION OF DECLARED LOCAL EMERGENCY CITY OF SUNNY ISLES BEACH, FLORIDA

WHEREAS, on March 12, 2020, the City Manager declared a Local Emergency, as a result of COVID-19; and

- WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 252.38(3)(a)5., F.S., political subdivisions have the power and authority to declare a state of local emergency for a period of up to seven (7) days, which may be extended as necessary, in seven (7) day increments; and
- WHEREAS, on March 19, 2020, the City Manager extended the Declaration of Local Emergency for an additional seven (7) days, until March 25, 2020; and
- WHEREAS, on March 26, 2020, the City Manager extended the Declaration of Local Emergency for an additional seven (7) days, until April 1, 2020; and
- WHEREAS, on April 2, 2020, the City Manager extended the Declaration of Local Emergency for an additional seven (7) days, until April 8, 2020; and
- WHEREAS, on April 9, 2020, the City Manager extended the Declaration of Local Emergency for an additional seven (7) days, until April 15, 2020; and
- **WHEREAS**, on April 16, 2020, the City Manager extended the Declaration of Local Emergency for an additional seven (7) days, until April 22, 2020; and
- **WHEREAS,** on April 23, 2020, the City Manager extended the Declaration of Local Emergency for an additional seven (7) days, until April 29, 2020; and
- WHEREAS, on April 30, 2020, the City Manager extended the Declaration of Local Emergency for an additional seven (7) days, until May 6, 2020; and
- **WHEREAS,** on May 7, 2020, the City Manager extended the Declaration of Local Emergency for an additional seven (7) days, until May 13, 2020; and
- WHEREAS, on May 14, 2020, the City Manager extended the Declaration of Local Emergency for an additional seven (7) days, until May 20, 2020; and
- WHEREAS, on May 21, 2020, the City Manager extended the Declaration of Local Emergency for an additional seven (7) days, until May 27, 2020; and
- WHEREAS, on May 28, 2020, the City Manager extended the Declaration of Local Emergency for an additional seven (7) days, until June 3, 2020; and
- WHEREAS, on June 4, 2020, the City Manager extended the Declaration of Local Emergency for an additional seven (7) days, until June 10, 2020; and
- WHEREAS, on June 11, 2020, the City Manager extended the Declaration of Local Emergency for an additional seven (7) days, until June 17, 2020; and
- **WHEREAS**, on June 18, 2020, the City Manager extended the Declaration of Local Emergency for an additional seven (7) days, until June 24, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on June 25, 2020, the City Manager extended the Declaration of Local Emergency for an additional seven (7) days, until July 1, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on July 2, 2020, the City Manager extended the Declaration of Local Emergency for an additional seven (7) days, until July 8, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on July 9, 2020, the City Manager extended the Declaration of Local Emergency for an additional seven (7) days, until July 15, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on July 16, 2020, the City Manager extended the Declaration of Local Emergency for an additional seven (7) days, until July 22, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on July 23, 2020, the City Manager extended the Declaration of Local Emergency for an additional seven (7) days, until July 29, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on July 30, 2020, the City Manager extended the Declaration of Local Emergency for an additional seven (7) days, until August 5, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on August 6, 2020, the City Manager extended the Declaration of Local Emergency for an additional seven (7) days, until August 12, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on August 13, 2020, the City Manager extended the Declaration of Local Emergency for an additional seven (7) days, until August 19, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on August 20, 2020, the City Manager extended the Declaration of Local Emergency for an additional seven (7) days, until August 26, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on August 27, 2020, the City Manager extended the Declaration of Local Emergency for an additional seven (7) days, until September 2, 2020; and

WHEREAS, due to COVID-19, the City Manager has determined that a condition of extreme peril of public health and welfare continues to exist, thereby necessitating the continued state of emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. An emergency continues to exist throughout the City of Sunny Isles Beach; and
- 2. The declared state of Local Emergency is hereby extended for an additional seven (7) days, until September 9, 2020.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that during the continued existence of said emergency the powers, functions, and duties of the City Manager/designee of the City of Sunny Isles Beach be those prescribed by State law and the ordinances, resolutions, and approved plans of the City of Sunny Isles Beach in order to mitigate the effects of said emergency.
