NEW ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR RESTAURANTS

Miami-Dade County issued **Emergency Order 28-20** ordering updated requirements for restaurants in addition to those outlined in the **New Normal Handbook**. Below are the updated guidelines restaurants must adhere to effective August 31, 2020:



Indoor dining restaurants are allowed to operate at 50% capacity, with six people maximum at a table, social distancing and facial coverings.



Restaurants and food service establishments with seating for more than eight people shall close for on-premises dining between 10 pm and 6 am the next morning.



Between the hours of 10 pm and 6 am, restaurants may operate their kitchens only for the purpose of providing delivery services, pick-up, room service, or take out services, and employees, janitorial personnel, contractors, and delivery personnel shall be allowed access to such establishments.



HVAC systems must run with the fan on while customers and/or employees are in the establishment (not set to "auto"). Any doors and windows must be open in order to allow for maximum air flow and circulation.



A per table party limit of 6 persons must be maintained whether seating is indoors or outdoors.



Customers must wear masks at all times unless seated at a table and actively engaged in eating or drinking.



Music shall be eliminated or set at a decibel level below that of a normal conversation.

Reminder: Restaurants must also comply with the guidelines listed in all current and future applicable **Miami-Dade County Emergency Orders** including, 20-20, 24-20, and 28-20, as well as the County's **New Normal Handbook**.
