

the ordinary and enjoy the comforts of Gateway Center, the City's newest and most innovative recreational and rental facility. When you walk in the entrance of Gateway Center, you'll be greeted by the contemporary and serene atmosphere, emblematic of our city's oceanfront location. Past the reception area and lobby, the facility guides you down Social Alley, a hallway with seating and game tables. This is a space for socialization, engagement, and leisure. As you stroll down Social Alley you'll see a fitness room - finished with oak wood floors and mirrored walls - a large multipurpose classroom, a full-fledged catering kitchen and adjacent small classroom, and the Roslyn Brezin Senior Lounge. At the end of Social Alley, you'll discover the ballroom, a spacious 3,600 square-foot event space. The proximity of the catering kitchen makes the ballroom perfect for weddings, banquets, business events, and other rental opportunities.

Gateway Center is truly a space where innovation and accessibility collide. A Hearing Loop system is a feature built into the floor of the ballroom and fitness room, and while invisible to the eye, this high-tech solution delivers sound from the AV system directly to hearing aids and cochlear implants, strengthening the sound of the presenter. A camera system designed to follow chefs cooking in the kitchen streams the video feed into the adjacent small classroom and has the capability to be played back at a later date. Gateway Center is unlike any other facility in the City and remains an icon of the accessibility we provide to all residents.

Residents with a valid City-issued Resident ID Card have an all-access pass to experience all Gateway Center has to offer. Experience any of one of our diverse programs, events, and activities that are curated for your enjoyment.
