

Payments must be made in full if registering online. If you would like to make partial payments, you must register in-person at Pelican Community Park, Gateway Center or the Sunny Isles Beach Government Center. Camp balances remain available for online payment.

REGISTRATION POLICIES

Residency Requirements - In order to ensure that priority is given to verified residents for space and discounted pricing, the City implements strict guidelines for proof of residency. Residents must have a valid City-issued SIB Resident ID Card in order to register during the priority period and to receive the discounted rates.

The registration fee for camp is a one-time, non-refundable fee (\$35 for residents, \$55 for non-residents). Only one registration fee may be applied for the summer, regardless of how many different camps you register for. This fee includes two t-shirts, participant insurance, and administrative processing fees. The registration form, the non-refundable registration fee, a copy of child's birth certificate, and a 50% (half) deposit of camp fees are required for camp enrollment.

The balance of camp fees is due by **June 1**. There are no grace periods on payments. If a payment is not received by the due date, your reservation will be forfeited, and your deposit will not be refunded. Financial assistance is not available for our programs.

PAYMENTS AND RETURNED CHECKS

Payments must be made in full if registering online. If registering in-person, payments can be due in two parts: half at the time of registration, and the final half due by June 1. Camp balances can be paid online at activities.sibfl.net. If you do not already have login credentials, you will receive them during the time of registration and can pay the summer camp balance online.

Any returned checks must be settled at the office with cash or money order, and will be assessed a \$30 "returned check" fee. This must be settled immediately or may result in your child's removal from the program.

ABSENCES

All camp fees are flat rates and cannot be prorated. Because staff schedules and activities are preplanned and paid for, we cannot prorate fees or accommodate make-up days due to campers missing a day of camp or a field trip.





Full Payment Discount

If you register your child for camp **before June 1** and choose to pay the full amount due at the time of registration, you will receive a discount off your total camp fees (10% discount for residents, 5% discount for non-residents).

Please note we are not able to offer sibling discounts or financial assistance at this time.



Refunds or transfers of camp fees can be made by submitting a **Refund/Transfer Request form** with at least 14 days notice to the Cultural & Community Services office. A cancellation/ transfer fee of \$20 per transaction will be deducted for any and all summer camp cancellations and/or transfers. Please understand that there is extensive administrative work involved in processing changes in your child's enrollment, and allocating a replacement. The form is available at Pelican Community Park or online at sibfl.net/CCS-Refund-Policy (As per "Absences" policy on page 4, we cannot issue partial refunds or credits for missed days of camp).



Once any camp becomes full, a wait list will be started for that week. Anyone interested in having their name placed on the wait list must fill out a wait list form (this is a short form with basic information about the potential participant as well as the parent or guardian).

Junior Lifeguard Camp is organized and run by certified City of Sunny Isles Beach lifeguards. Campers learn basic skills of lifeguarding, including first aid, ocean safety, and rescue techniques. Campers will spend more than 75% of each day outside in the sun. Campers should bring their swimsuit, towel, change of clothes, plenty of sunscreen, cap/hat, water bottle, and a bag lunch every day.

REQUIREMENTS: CAMPERS MUST ALREADY KNOW HOW TO SWIM. THIS IS NOT A SWIMMING COURSE!

Campers must be able to endure strenuous activity (there is a great deal of running and swimming outdoors). If your child has any medical conditions (e.g. heart problems, diabetes, or asthma), you must get clearance from your child's doctor before registering for the program.

Completion of this course DOES NOT provide camper certification in lifeguarding. This is only an informational program, not a certification program.


